

Repeal the Evil Act

End Abortion South Africa calls on The President of South Africa, his cabinet, the members of South Africa's Parliament and other politicians to repeal **the Choice of Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1996, Act No.2 1996** and **the Choice of Termination of Pregnancy Amendment Act, 2008, Act No. 1 of 2008 (CToP)** and to recognize that the life of human beings start at conception as recognized by Scripture.

The former National Party government passed **the Abortion and Sterilization Act 2 of 1975 (RSA)** that allowed for the murder of preborn babies if the mother's health was in danger, the baby was unhealthy or was conceived through incest or rape.

In 1996 the African National Congress removed the previous limits to the murder of preborn babies with the passing in the National Assembly of **the Choice of Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1996, Act No.2 1996** and **the Choice of Termination of Pregnancy Amendment Act, 2008, Act No. 1 of 2008 (CToP)**.

South African law is inconsistent in that the murder of a preborn baby is legally permitted, yet when a pregnant woman is murdered, the murderer is guilty of the murder of her preborn baby as well as of the mother.

The Bible recognizes the humanity of a baby from conception and so we call on our government to recognize this fact as well.

***"For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made...Your eyes saw my unformed substance; in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them."** (Ps. 139:13-16)*

God will not bless a nation that murders preborn babies! We can sing *Nkosi Sikelel iAfrika (God bless Africa)* for another 27 years, but God has said He will curse a nation that sheds innocent blood (Prov. 6:17). The most innocent blood is that of preborn babies.

God clearly states in Holy Scripture:

“You shall not murder!” (6th commandment; Ex 20:13)

Babies as murdered by medical professionals. That the government is forcing or coercing medical professionals to murder preborn children, is tyranny of the highest order and places the current government squarely in the same position as that of the pre-1994 National Party. But there is a difference. The ANC has allowed for a greater genocide than what the National Party did. The ANC is effectively doing this to masses of black South African citizens. Our State hospitals, which should be places for healing, have been turned into slaughter houses where preborn babies are violently dismembered in their mothers wombs.

Babies are poisoned by chemicals like the gas chambers of NAZI Germany. Millions of South African babies have been murdered in their mothers womb through the use of the abortion pill, which is dispensed at government hospitals and municipal clinics. The number of medical professionals that are guilty of murder as a result cannot be overestimated.

Abortion is child sacrifice under the guise of benefitting the mother and society, but God proclaims: “*And if the people of the land should in any way hide their eyes from the man, when he gives some of his descendants to Molech, and they do not kill him,⁵ then I will set My face against that man and against his family; and I will cut him off from his people, and all who prostitute themselves with him to commit harlotry with Molech.*” (Leviticus 20:4-5) The Israelites sacrificed children by fire to the idol Molech, and God hated it.

God who raised up Israel also destroyed Israel. God has destroyed many nations before and He has established many other nations including South Africa. He can and will destroy disobeying nations. God warns nations who are murdering preborn babies:

“The instant I speak concerning a nation and concerning a kingdom, to pluck up, to pull down, and to destroy it, if that nation against whom I have spoken turns from its evil, I will relent of the disaster that I thought to bring upon it. And the instant I speak concerning a nation and concerning a kingdom, to build and to plant it, if it does evil in My sight so that it does not obey My voice, then I will relent concerning the good with which I said I would benefit it.” (Jeremiah 18:7-10)
